Female Funnel web



Male Funnel web



Large ground dwelling 1.5-4.5cm. Highly toxic can cause death. Male 6 times more toxic than the female

Female Mouse spider



Male Red headed Mouse spider



Smaller than the Funnel web. Highly toxic, male often has coloured body parts.

Female Trapdoor



Male Trapdoor



Ground dwelling low toxicity often mistaken for Funnel web, large brown

Female Red back



Related to the black widow

Female bulbous abdomen with stripe. Makes loose webbing, highly toxic bite. Red back Male is *not* toxic.

White-tailed spider



Long thin 1-2cm white tip and 4 spots on abdomen. Very dangerous

Wolf spider



Agile ground hunter. Dull colours painful bite.

Black house spider



Makes felted webs, not aggressive but has a toxic painful bite.

Huntsman spider



Often mistaken for a tarantula

Large flat and hairy leg span can be 15 cm not aggressive but mildly toxic.

Orb weavers, Garden spider



Often makes webs across garden paths, mildly toxic and is reluctant to bite.
